<p>Summary of Event</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Implementation of ICT Tools in Pharmacognosy Unit Test</p> <p>The Department of Pharmacognosy conducted a unit test for Pharmacognosy I B. Pharm IV Semester using ICT tools, specifically Google Forms, to enhance digital learning and evaluation. Information and Communication Technology (ICT) plays a crucial role in modern education by making assessments more efficient, transparent, and student-friendly. It allows instant feedback, reduces manual effort, and promotes interactive learning among students.</p> <p>The test was based on Unit II and consisted of 15 multiple-choice questions designed to assess students’ understanding of key concepts. A total of 56 students from Division A and B participated in the test. The use of Google Forms enabled smooth execution, with features such as automatic question shuffling and randomized options ensuring academic integrity. Each student received a different sequence of questions, minimizing the chances of copying and encouraging individual performance.</p> <p>Among the participants, students from Division A—Tanvi Shelke, Sanika Bodkhe, Atharv Borole, and Akash Chincholkar—achieved full marks (15/15) in a remarkably short time, demonstrating excellent preparation and subject understanding.</p> <p>After the test, the question paper was discussed with all students to clarify concepts and address doubts. A quick revision (speed repetition) of previously taught topics was also conducted to reinforce learning outcomes. 




RBC Hitchhiking a vascular delivery approach in HIV/AIDS: A Critical Review

ABSTRACT
The study gave a clear concept about the deadly disease named AIDS and currently, no cure can be found to prevent the adverse effect of this disease. AIDS mainly occurs after the attack of the Human immunodeficiency virus. The current study has demonstrated that RBC hitchhiking can be considered as one of the most accepted models of treatment for AIDS. RBCs can be easily available and it has the best circulatory capacity among all RBCs, has the capability to bind with multiple substrates and also travel to every part of the host's tissue. In addition, Macrophages cannot treat RBC as foreign material, hence it will successfully reduce the chances of phagocytosis. RBC can be considered one of the best carriers for delivering drugs and also strengthening the immune response against HIV. However, in some cases, the immune cells of the host body cannot determine its own RBC. Therefore, encapsulation is required before transferring antiretroviral drugs in the body of the host's cells. The particular hitchhiking therapy showed less risk of failure and the dosage of drugs can be further modified in this case. Patients affected by HIV have been showing a noticeable response against the virus after successfully implementing drugs within their bodies.
