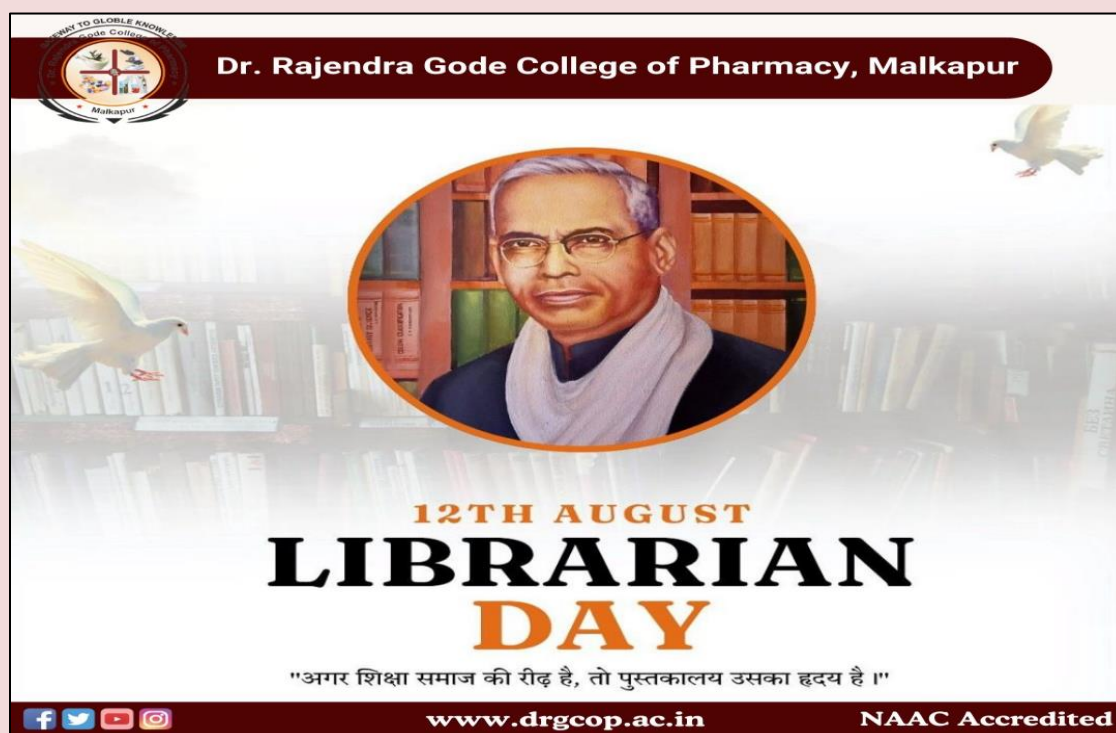

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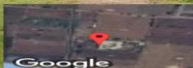

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Summary of Event	As part of innovative teaching-learning practices and experiential learning initiatives, the Department of Pharmaceutics conducted an interactive quiz on the topic <i>Controlled Release Drug Delivery System</i> (CRDDS). The quiz was designed and facilitated by Dr. R. R. Thenge using the Kahoot platform, which allows gamified learning through real-time participation and scoring. The activity aimed to assess student knowledge, encourage active learning, and build enthusiasm for the subject while promoting healthy competition among the students of Semester VII B. Pharmacy. The objective of the activity was - To reinforce key concepts of <i>Controlled Release Drug Delivery Systems</i> through an interactive test. - To enhance student engagement and motivation using digital tools. - To develop critical thinking and quick decision-making skills among students. - To foster a spirit of teamwork and healthy competition in an academic setting. Total 12 team were participated and having 20 MCQs were perform on Kahoot Interactive platform. Rohit Waktes team was the First Winner, Partik Gawa's team holds second position and Runner was Samruddhi Gawarguru's team. Students reported that the Kahoot test was highly engaging and enjoyable. They appreciated the instant scoring system and the competitive environment which motivated them to perform better. Many students expressed that this method made complex pharmaceutics concepts easier to remember and apply. The Kahoot-based quiz on <i>Controlled Release Drug Delivery Systems</i> conducted by Dr. R. R. Thenge was a successful experiential learning initiative. It effectively combined technology with academics, enhanced student participation, and improved conceptual clarity. The activity not only tested theoretical knowledge but also promoted interactive learning, analytical thinking, and professional skills, aligning with the Program Outcomes (POs) of pharmacy education

Formulation And Evaluation Of Lquisolid Compact For Pazopanib

ABSTRACT
Objective: The aim of the present investigation was to develop a liquisolid compacts to enhance the oral absorption of Pazopanib by improving dissolution rate. Experimental work: the solubility of pazopanib in various liquid vehicles was determined. Liquisolid compacts were prepared using polyethylene glycol as a solvent, microcrystalline cellulose as carrier materials and silica as coating material. The interaction between drug and excipients were characterized by FTIR. The powder characteristics were evaluated by different flow parameters to comply with pharmacopoeial limits. The dissolution studies for liquisolid compacts and conventional formulations were carried out. Results and Discussion: liquisolid compacts showed significant higher drug release rates than conventional tablets. Formulation F3 showed superior dissolution and are more effective carrier materials for liquid adsorption. Conclusion: it was concluded that liquisolid compacts would be a promising drug delivery system for poorly water-soluble drugs by the oral route.
