



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

<b>Summary of Event</b>	<p>In a bid to strengthen student understanding of advanced drug delivery systems, the Department of Pharmaceutics at [College Name] organized a one-hour discussion session on neosomes for the B.Pharm Semester VIII students. The session, held from 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM, was led by Dr. R. R. Thenge and attracted enthusiastic participation from students and faculty alike.</p> <p>The interactive session began with a concise introduction to the challenges in conventional drug delivery, followed by the definition of neosomes and a comparative overview with liposomes, niosomes, and other vesicular systems. Students and faculty delved into preparation techniques such as thin film hydration and sonication, and examined crucial characterization parameters including particle size, zeta potential, encapsulation efficiency, stability, and The session also addressed real-world challenges: scale-up, reproducibility, regulatory hurdles, and long-term stability. Several students volunteered mini-project topics, demonstrating the inspiration drawn from the discourse. Feedback at the close was overwhelmingly positive, with students appreciating the clarity, interactive format, and relevance to their future research work.</p> <p>Dr. Thenge concluded by urging further exploration and follow-up workshops or demonstrations to consolidate student learning. The session was expertly delivered by Miss Samruddhi Gawarguru, who opened with the fundamental structure and classification of liposomes, covering small unilamellar vesicles (SUVs), large unilamellar vesicles (LUVs), multilamellar vesicles (MLVs), as well as stealth and targeted variants. She proceeded to elucidate the principal preparation methods, including thin-film hydration, solvent injection, and reverse-phase evaporation, supplemented by insight into emerging microfluidic techniques. The presentation then shifted focus to the evaluation and characterisation of liposomal formulations, addressing key parameters such as vesicle size and distribution, lamellarity, surface charge (zeta potential), drug entrapment efficiency, release kinetics and biocompatibility. During the interactive Q&amp;A segment, attendees — comprising faculty, postgraduate students and research scholars — raised insightful queries regarding scale-up challenges, regulatory frameworks and real-world marketed liposomal drugs. The seminar succeeded in enhancing awareness of liposome-based drug delivery systems, fostering research interest among participants and underscoring the importance of hands-on workshops to reinforce learning. Dr Thenge concluded by recommending a follow-up lab workshop and circulation of presentation slides and curated reading material to sustain momentum in this evolving field.</p> <p>The activity not only tested theoretical knowledge but also promoted interactive learning, analytical thinking, and professional skills, aligning with the Program Outcomes (POs) of pharmacy education</p>



<b>Summary of Event</b>	<p>A well-attended seminar titled “Nanoparticles: Types, Method and Evaluation” was organized on 16 October 2025 at 11:30 AM by the Department under the guidance of Dr R. R. Thenge. The session was delivered by Miss Vijaya Bansod, who commenced with a comprehensive overview of nanoparticles, defining their scale (typically 1–100 nm) and unique properties like high surface-area-to-volume ratio and size-effect behaviour. She then elaborated on the various classifications of nanoparticles — for example, inorganic vs organic, metallic vs polymeric, and carbon-based types — and explained their relevance across biomedical, environmental and industrial domains. In the methods section, Miss Bansod described both “top-down” and “bottom-up” approaches to nanoparticle synthesis, including mechanical milling, laser ablation and chemical reduction, sol–gel and co-precipitation methods. She also pointed to more recent plant-mediated “green synthesis” routes of nanoparticles. Moving into evaluation techniques, the presentation covered key characterisation parameters such as particle size and distribution (e.g., via transmission electron microscopy and dynamic light scattering), surface charge (zeta potential), morphology (SEM/TEM), crystallinity (XRD) and composition (EDX/FTIR). She referenced that reliable evaluation often requires combining multiple analytical techniques to overcome nanoscale challenges. The interactive portion of the seminar invited questions about scale-up of nanoparticle preparations, regulatory and safety considerations, and application scenarios, which drew good engagement from students and research scholars. The session succeeded in enhancing awareness of nanoparticle science, fostered interest in research work within the department, and underscored the value of organising hands-on workshops or lab demonstrations in the future. Dr Thenge concluded by recommending circulation of the slides and arranging follow-up practical sessions for experimental exposure.</p> <p>The activity not only tested theoretical knowledge but also promoted interactive learning, analytical thinking, and professional skills, aligning with the Program Outcomes (POs) of pharmacy education</p>





<b>Summary of Event</b>	<p>On Friday 17 October 2025, at 10:30 AM, Miss Swati Katone delivered a focused seminar on “Monoclonal Antibody: Types, Method and Evaluation”, moderated by Dr. R. R. Thenge. The session commenced with the facilitator’s welcome and a brief introduction of the topic and speaker.</p> <p>Miss Katone began by defining monoclonal antibodies (mAbs) and explaining their genesis from a single clone of cells, emphasising their specificity and significance in diagnostics and therapeutics. She then described the various types of mAbs — murine, chimeric, humanised and fully human — and touched upon advanced formats such as bispecific antibodies. Drawing from standard sources, she highlighted the classification based on origin and structure.</p> <p>Next, she outlined the methods of production and development of mAbs: from classic hybridoma technology to modern recombinant and display-based technologies, including screening and expression strategies. Examples of analytical and functional assessment followed, covering evaluation criteria such as binding affinity, specificity, purity, stability and functional assays. The seminar underscored regulatory and quality-control importance in mAb development.</p> <p>The interactive Q&amp;A session raised pertinent questions about scale-up challenges, regulatory frameworks, cost implications and future directions of mAb technology. Miss Katone addressed these clearly, adding value to the discussion.</p> <p>In summary, the seminar successfully provided participants with a well-structured overview of monoclonal antibody technology: its types, production methods and evaluation approaches. Attendees were actively engaged, and the facilitator concluded by reinforcing the importance of rigorous methodology and evaluation in biopharmaceutical development of mAbs.</p>

**Abstract**

The study aimed to enhance the oral bioavailability of Ritonavir (RTV), a poorly soluble HIV protease inhibitor, by formulating polymeric microspheres using the biodegradable copolymer poly(ethylene glycol)-b-poly(methacrylic acid) (PEGA). The effect of PEGA concentration on the drug loading was evaluated by evaluating the effects of drug-to-polymer ratio ( $X_0$ ) and sonication time ( $X_0$ ) on particle size ( $V_0$ ) and encapsulation efficiency (VE). The optimized RTV-loaded polymeric microspheres (RTV-PMs) exhibited a mean particle size of 240 nm and a drug loading of 10.2% with an encapsulation efficiency of 92.4  $\pm$  3.5%. Transmission electron microscopy confirmed their spherical morphology and uniform size distribution. In vitro release studies revealed a biphasic pattern with an initial burst followed by sustained release, achieving 85% cumulative release within 48 hours. Caco-2 cell permeability studies showed a 4.7-fold increase in apparent permeability (Papp) compared to pure RTV, indicating increased intestinal transport. In vitro efflux/transporter interaction on cell lines revealed a  $\Psi$  of 8.4.

**Herbal Transfersomal Gel For Diabetic Wound Healing Using Azadirachta Indica, Ocimum Sanctum, And Allium Sativum**

**ABSTRACT**  
Diabetic wounds are a major clinical challenge due to impaired healing, prolonged inflammation, and increased risk of infection. Herbal medicines such as Azadirachta indica, Ocimum sanctum, and Allium sativum possess anti-inflammatory, antimicrobial, and antioxidant properties that can enhance wound repair. However, their therapeutic potential is often limited by poor stability, low solubility, and incomplete bioavailability. Transfersomal gel is a novel delivery system that uses a mixture of aqueous extracts to improve topical delivery and accelerate wound healing. Transfomers were prepared and characterized for particle size, polydispersity index (PDI), zeta potential, and entrapment efficiency. The optimized formulation (F7) was incorporated into a gel and evaluated for its in vivo performance in terms of wound contraction, granulation tissue formation, and safety as well as in vitro drug release and stability under ICH conditions. In vivo studies using streptozotocin-induced diabetic rats assessed wound contraction and healing efficacy. The optimized gel showed uniform particle size ( $165 \pm 2.5$  nm), high entrapment efficiency (92.5%), and a drug release of  $85 \pm 2.5\%$  over 24 hours. A significant increase in wound contraction and drug release was observed over 24 hours, and stability studies confirmed physical and chemical integrity. In vivo results demonstrated significantly enhanced wound contraction (92.5% by day 21) compared to herbal gel and control groups.

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
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## FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS



I am delighted to share my PhD journey, during which I contributed to the discovery of a novel gene responsible for hereditary hearing impairment. Discovery of deafness genes and elucidating their functions have substantially contributed to our understanding of hearing physiology and its pathologies.

This research focused on identifying inherited disorders in families with multiple affected individuals across generations, with special emphasis on hereditary hearing impairment common in India. The primary aim was to understand the genetic causes and inheritance patterns of non-syndromic sensorineural hearing loss (HL) and to enable early genetic counselling and interventions for affected communities. Four families with autosomal recessive HL were studied—two of Turkish and two of Indian ancestry. In all cases, hearing loss began at birth or early childhood and progressed rapidly to a severe or profound degree. Audiological evaluations, including ABR and otoacoustic emissions, confirmed combined inner hair cell, neuronal, and outer hair cell dysfunction.

Blood samples were collected with informed consent, followed by DNA extraction, PCR amplification, and whole-exome sequencing to identify causative variants. Several benign variants were ruled out using population frequency databases. Pathogenic variants in the MINAR2 gene, including c.144G>A, c.412\_419del, and c.393G>T, were identified as the underlying cause of autosomal recessive nonsyndromic deafness. Functional studies in transgenic Minar2 mice demonstrated early-onset, progressive HL consistent with human findings, highlighting the gene's critical role in inner-ear development. These results establish MINAR2 as essential for hearing and suggest potential avenues for future genetic therapies.
