Pharm Second Year students (Division A and Division B). The activity was conducted on 10 and 12 March 2026 from 10:30 AM to 11:30 AM with the objective of enhancing students' practical knowledge of medicinal plants and strengthening their understanding of pharmacognosy through experiential learning.</p> <p>The program was organized under the inspiration and guidance of Hon. Shri Yogendraji Gode Sir, President, and Miss Tanvi Gode Ma'am, Secretary of IBSS, Buldana. The activity also received valuable support and encouragement from Principal Dr. P. K. Deshmukh and IQAC Head Dr. V. S. Adhao, whose leadership continuously promotes innovative teaching and learning practices aligned with academic quality standards..</p> <p>During the visit, subject teacher Prof. V. N. Ghait guided the students through the Digital Medicinal Plant Garden and explained the importance of various medicinal and aromatic plants.
